After extensive discovery and motion practice, the Plaintiff voluntarily dismissed our client with no settlement payment.

Wrongful Foreclosure: Represented independent oil and gas companies and commercial vendors in several suits to collect on promissory notes, foreclose on collateral and including fraudulent transfers.

Trade Secrets and Restrictive Covenants: Prevailed in multiple temporary restraining order and temporary injunction proceedings involving trade secret and restrictive covenant claims in multiple industries, including insurance, fiber optics, industrial gases and products, and financial services.

Kickbacks: Represented a family investment office in obtaining a \$15 million judgment involving paying kickbacks to, and otherwise aiding and abetting, former agents' breaches of fiduciary duties and fraud in connection with the purchase of millions of dollars in inventory, including obtaining cash payments and the denials of bankruptcy discharges.

Legal Malpractice: Obtained a voluntary dismissal of legal malpractice claims made against a prominent Houston attorney after winning two summary judgments and other favorable rulings prior to trial. The Plaintiff withdrew the claims and dismissed the case with no settlement payment.

Accounting Malpractice: Litigated and favorably resolved extensive multi-jurisdiction matter regarding accounting malpractice claims in numerous suits throughout Texas, California, and New York regarding alleged leveraged foreign currency option tax shelters and corporate tax returns and accounting.
